Aaron Lee is a prize-winning poet and writing mentor. He is also the co-editor of the anthologies *No Other City* and *Love Gathers All*. His work has appeared in many publications in Singapore and elsewhere. His first collection of poems released fully authored by him, *A Visitation of Sunlight*, was named one of the best books of 1997 by *The Straits Times*. The collection was well received and played a part in a late 1990s resurgence of interest in Singapore poetry centred around a new generation of Singapore poets. His new collection of poetry *Five Right Angles* was released in June last year.

Felix Cheong Seng Fei (b. 1965, Singapore -) is a poet and a recipient of the National Arts Council (NAC) Young Artist Award for Literature in 2000 and has published three volumes of poems.
