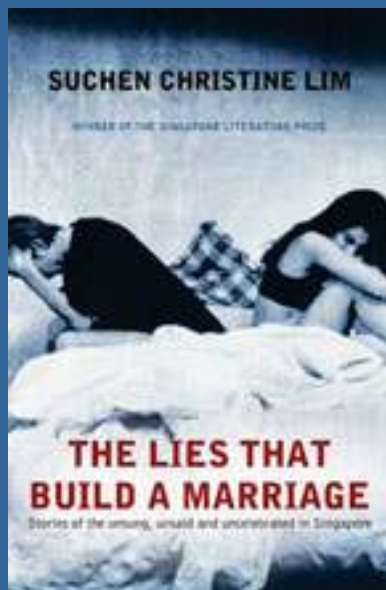


# THE SINGAPORE BOOK CLUB

Suchen Christine Lim is a prize-winning author. She was awarded the inaugural Singapore Literature Prize in 1992 for her novel, *Fistful of Colours*. Her fourth novel, *A Bit of Earth*, was short listed for the same prize in 2004. Suchen's other novels are *Ricebowl* and *Gift from The Gods*. Her latest book, *The Lies That Build A Marriage*, is a collection of short stories. Besides fiction, Suchen Christine Lim has written extensively for schools. 11 of her children's stories were published as Big Books by SNP Singapore for the Ministry of Education. In 1997, she was awarded a Fulbright fellowship to attend the International Writers' Program in the University of Iowa and returned as the university's International Writer-in-Residence in 2000. In 2005, she was writer-in-residence in Scotland, where she conducted writing sessions in Scottish schools. She has taught creative writing in Ateneo de Manila University, and has mentored Singapore students in the Creative Arts Programme and adult writers in the National Arts Council Mentor Access Programme.
